JANUARY

January 17 — Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day commemorates the birth, life, achievements of this influential American civil rights leader and activist for nonviolent social change until his assassination in 1968. Dr. King received the 1964 Nobel Peace Prize. LiveVox celebrates MLK Day as a US National Holiday.



FEBRUARY

Black History Month

Black History Month is an annual celebration of achievements by African Americans and a time for recognizing their central role in U.S. history. Also known as African American History Month, the event grew out of “Negro History Week,” the brainchild of noted historian Carter G. Woodson and other prominent African Americans. Since 1976, every U.S. president has officially designated the month of February as Black History Month. Other countries around the world, including Canada and the United Kingdom, also devote a month to celebrating Black history. In the past, LiveVox has hosted a book club lunch & learn session with recommended reading lists to foster meaningful dialogue and celebrate.



MARCH

Women’s History Month

Women’s History Month is a celebration of women’s contributions to history, culture and society and has been observed annually in the month of March in the United States since 1987. Women’s History Month is a dedicated month to reflect on the often-overlooked contributions of women. **International Women’s Day**, a global celebration of the economic, political and social achievements of women, took place for the first time on March 8, 1911. Many countries around the world celebrate the holiday with demonstrations and educational initiatives. The LiveVox Women’s Affinity Resource Group typically hosts a virtual lunch & learn featuring a LiveVox employee discussing issues of importance. We also celebrate women via our social media presence.



APRIL

Celebrate Diversity Month April 22 — Earth Day

April is Celebrate Diversity Month, started in 2004 to recognize and honor the diversity surrounding us all. By celebrating differences and similarities during this month, organizers hope that people will get a deeper understanding of each other.

JUNE

Stonewall Month (LGBTQ PRIDE) Juneteenth

The purpose of the commemorative month is to recognize the positive impact that lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals have had on history locally, nationally, and internationally and to create awareness and goodwill. Pride Month is celebrated each year in June to honor the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in Manhattan. Our employees are encouraged to mark this important time by learning, donating, and discovering LGBTQ+ examples in popular culture. Many like to gather with friends and families to celebrate Pride.

June 19th (Juneteenth) is the oldest nationally celebrated commemoration of the emancipation of enslaved people in the United States. LiveVox recognizes the importance of June 19 and as of 2022 it has been added as a floating holiday.



SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER

Hispanic Heritage Month — Wednesday, September 15 through Friday, October 15 LiveVox Colombia Appreciation Month National Disability Employment Awareness Month

In the autumn we celebrate the history, culture, and contributions of Hispanic-Americans and of our Colombia-based LiveVox teammates. In the US, many of our ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Central and South America. We mark the achievements of Hispanic and Latino Americans and our Colombian teams with festivals and educational activities. We honor and encourage our employees to join us in experiencing some of the traditions unique to this cultural background and by supporting businesses in the Hispanic community.

October is also National Disability Employment Awareness Month. This observance was launched in 1945 when Congress declared the first week in October as “National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week.” In 1998, the week was extended to a month and renamed. The annual event draws attention to employment barriers that still need to be addressed.



NOVEMBER

November 11 — Veterans Day International Men’s Month Native American Heritage Month

A celebration to honor America’s veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the good of our nation.

International Men’s Day (celebrated on November 19) emphasizes the important issues affecting males, including health issues that affect males, improving the relations between genders, highlighting the importance of male role models, and promoting gender equality. This holiday is celebrated in over 80 countries.

November is also National Native American Heritage Month, which celebrates the history and contributions of Native Americans.



DECEMBER

December 3 — International Day of Persons with Disabilities

This day is designated to raise awareness in regards to persons who are differently abled in order to improve their lives and provide them with equal opportunity.
